



## CAMP MCLANLIN GENERAL INFORMATION


“Camp Mac” is supported by Fraser Skies Area and managed by the Camp McLanlin Committee.


It is used by Guiding members from all levels, girls & adults, for short & long term camps as well as for adult training evenings & weekends. It can also be rented for day use activities.


Camp McLanlin is open throughout the year for residential camping & spring to fall for tent camping. Winter tent camping can be available by special arrangement


 **Water** is available at all tent sites & residences and is tested on a regular basis by the Public Health Unit. **\*\*Please check with booking agent if bottled water is needed.**

 **Parking** is limited. Please park only in designated areas.


 **Be Bear Aware** – keep a clean campsite.


 **Pets** are NOT allowed at camp. This is a BC Provincial health regulation.


 **Garbage & Recycling:** Currently all garbage & recyclables must be taken home by the group after camp, there is no pickup or garbage disposal at camp.


 **Chapel:** situated above Camelot nestled within the forest, complete with chimes (seasonal).


 **Site & Trail Maps:** available at camp


 Dry **firewood** provided at all sites, bring your own axe and newspaper.


 **Creek:** is out of bounds. No wading or bathing as this is a water source to residents downstream and spawning stream.

 **Games:** Book with caretaker upon arrival for archery, bocce, frisbee golf, badminton and volleyball. (some are seasonal)


 **Common Field:** situated near Camelot & Avalon—for use by all groups/sites.

 **Picnic Tables** are secured in place, please do not move as this will cause damage to the tables and the ground around the campsite.

 **Gadget Wood:** there can be a lot of windfall in the area for gadget building and use. Please use only fallen sticks and return to wooded area untied upon completion of camp.

 **Bamboo Poles** for gadget building are available – please ask the caretaker.

 Ask about the **Camp McLanlin Challenge & Letterboxing.**

 **Crests** can be obtained from the caretaker at camp with the cost included on your invoice.

## RESIDENTIAL SITES

*Both are wheelchair accessible.*

### ROBIN'S ROOST

- year round facility
- 30 bunks with mattresses
- large washroom for girls
- leaders washroom with shower
- kitchen with commercial propane gas stove with grill & oven, fridge, freezer, dishes, cutlery, pots & pans, cleaning supplies
- enclosed outdoor area suitable for activities and crafts
- chairs and folding tables on site
- outdoor space includes a Flag pole, field for games
- campfire ring with benches (firewood supplied)

### MARION'S MANOR

- year round facility
- 28 bunks with mattresses
- modern, fully equipped kitchen same as Robin's Roost
- indoor washroom
- covered outside area with picnic tables, flag pole, campfire ring with benches (firewood supplied).

## TENT SITES

### SHERWOOD & CAMELOT

- Camelot has seven 9X12 platform tents
- Sherwood – **under renovation ready soon!**
- space available to pitch additional tents
- large shelter has electricity, fridge, counter space, 3 burner propane stove (propane supplied) , coffee pot, freezer, wood burning heater and picnic tables
- outdoor picnic tables, open field & campfire area. (firewood supplied)
- must bring food storage bins

### AVALON

- semi-wilderness site for smaller groups
- no tents or shelter provided
- water
- LDP
- firewood & firepit
- NO ELECTRICITY

### WASHROOM FACILITIES

Sherwood facilities are at the end of Marion's Manor. Camelot & Avalon—washroom building has flush toilets on Camelot site to be shared.

## BOOKING PROCEDURE

### FRASER SKIES AREA MEMBERS

Bookings accepted up to one year in advance.

### OTHER GGC MEMBERS

Bookings accepted up to six months in advance.

### FOR NON GUIDING GROUPS

Bookings accepted up to six months in advance.

You will be required to provide proof of liability insurance and complete a 3rd. Party License Agreement. The booking fee is **NOT** included in your total camp cost.

### SEASONAL DISCOUNTS FOR TENT SITES

- **April/May/June** - High Season - Full Rate
- **July/August/September** - Low Season Discount 15%
- **November to February** - tenting sites are closed due to water being shut off
- **March & October** - Shoulder Season Discount 10%

Bookings accepted by e-mail in received order.

Bookings will be held for ten business days to allow time for the following to be sent:

### BOOKING FEE

- must be dated with current date
- see rate chart for amount

### DAMAGE / SECURITY DEPOSIT

- \$100.00 per site
- must be dated with the date of your camp
- returned after your camp if there are no charges for damages or missing items

### MINIMUM CAMP FEE

To calculate the minimum fee multiply the minimum number of people for the site times the number of nights.

### WEEKEND MINIMUM TWO (2) NIGHTS

Booking Fee, Damage/Security Deposit and Minimum Camp Fee must be received by the Booking Agent to **confirm** your booking.

Please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope for receipts and the return of your damage deposit.

### NOTIFICATION OF CANCELLATION OF YOUR CAMP

is required at least 2 months before your scheduled camp date or you will be responsible for the minimum payment.

**PLEASE INFORM THE BOOKING AGENT OF ANY CHANGES.**

#1 way.... a little longer but well lit all the way to Upper Sumas Mt. Rd

Off Highway #1 - take the Sumas Exit and head north turn right at the lights onto Marshall Rd.

Left on McMillan Rd.

Right on McKee Rd.

Left on Upper Sumas Mt Rd

Left on Straiton Rd.

Right on Willet Rd to the end

#2 way

Off Highway # 1 – take the Sumas Exit and head north

Right on Highway #7 (Mission Highway)

Right on Clayburn Rd.

Left on Straiton Rd

Left on Willet Rd to end

Please be advised the route to camp using Sumas Mountain Road is not recommended due to damage from a washout.
