West Coast Area Bursaries

Available for Guiding members in West Coast Area to assist with post-secondary education. Bursaries will be awarded as follows:

Ten (10) bursaries for members in Grade 12

Five (5) bursaries for members ages 18-24

Two (2) bursaries for members age 25 or older

Designed to help active members with the cost of post-secondary education at a recognized institution. Candidates will be evaluated in the following areas: Guiding involvement; service/volunteer positions outside of Guiding; interests and activities; applicant's letter; reference letters. March 31st Deadline

Jennifer Menendez Education Grant

Open to any girl or young woman age 17 to 25 presently registered in Guiding within Richmond, Ladner or Tsawwassen. It is presented to a girl / young woman whose outstanding personal qualities merit this award. Designed to help active members with the cost of post-secondary education at a recognized institution. Candidates will be evaluated in the following areas: Guiding involvement; service/volunteer positions outside of Guiding; interests and activities; applicant's letter; reference letters. March 31st Deadline

Elizabeth Rogers Music Scholarship

Open to Brownies, Guides, Pathfinders and Rangers in Vancouver, Burnaby, New Westminster, Richmond, Ladner and Tsawwassen. One scholarship will be awarded to each branch. Girls performing on any musical instrument are eligible. Criteria for the award includes: the applicant's interest in her music; the applicant's commitment to Guiding and her music; and her active use of her talent particularly in Guiding and in the community. March 31st Deadline.

Elizabeth Rogers Trust Scholarship

A scholarship is offered to members of West Coast Area Girl Guides through UBC (Check UBC information for applications). Applicants must be active members of the Girl Guides movement in Vancouver (including UBC), Richmond, or Burnaby and be enrolled in a full program of studies leading to a degree. Academic standing is considered together with interest in Girl Guide activities. Winners are selected by the University in consultation with the West Coast Area Girl Guides Area Council. Confirm Deadline with UBC.

Beatrice Malkin Performing Arts Scholarship

Open to Brownies, Guides, Pathfinders and Rangers in Guiding within the City of Vancouver. One scholarship will be awarded to each branch. Performing Arts includes speech, drama (including mime), voice (singing and speech), dance, rhythmic gymnastics, figure skating and any other performance art (other than a musical instrument) that can be evaluated. Criteria includes: the applicant's interest in her performing art; the applicant's commitment to Guiding, her performing art; and her active use of her talent particularly in Guiding and in the community. March 31st Deadline

Bertha Brandreth Award

Open to Guiding members within the City of Vancouver between 13 yrs. and 18 yrs. at the time of application. Application must be initiated by the Guider. Will be presented to an outstanding member of Guiding. Funds are to be used for a Guiding event or educational opportunity within 12 months of presentation that will foster the development of the member in accordance with the principles of Guiding. March 31st Deadline.
